Chris Bostic is ASH's Deputy Director for Policy, and has been working in global tobacco control since 2001 when he attended the negotiations for the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control as a civil society international law expert. Bostic holds a juris doctorate from the Washington College of Law, and a master of science in Foreign Service from Georgetown University.
