LCAR's 45-day review period for proposed rule 13-P45 ends on March 15, 2014. We have been informed by the House Ways and Means Committee that they are considering legislative action to repeal the statutory sales tax exemption the rule would implement. For that reason, we would like to extend LCAR's review period until July 15, 2014. This extension will allow time for the completion of any legislative action and an appropriate re-assessment of the proposed rule by our agency.
