Rep. Marek presided over the meeting in the absence of the Chair, Sen. MacDonald.

The minutes of the meeting of April 24, 2014 were approved.

The committee reviewed the following rules:

**14-P06 - Department of Financial Regulation/Vermont Small Business Offering Exemption.** Michael Pieciak, Deputy Commissioner for the Department of Financial Regulation, presented the rule to the committee. The rule codifies, with changes, an existing order applicable to intrastate securities transactions in Vermont. Mr. Pieciak and Daniel Raddock, Assistant Attorney General for the Department of Financial Regulation, responded to questions from the committee.

The committee deferred action on the rule to its next meeting on Thursday, May 29, 2014.

**14-P04 – Vermont Board of Pharmacy/Administrative Rules of the Board of Pharmacy.** Larry Novins, Counsel for the Office of Professional Regulation, presented the rule

to the committee. The rule adopts a new section on remote pharmacies and includes other revisions in response to recent legislation. Mr. Novins and Jeffrey Firlik, Chair of the Board of Pharmacy, responded to questions from the committee.

On a motion by Sen. Snelling, the committee unanimously approved the rule as submitted.

The next meeting of the committee is scheduled for May 29, 2014, beginning at 10:00 a.m. in the Ethan Allen Room of the State House in Montpelier, Vermont.
