Senator Mullin moves that the Senate concur in the House Proposal of Amendment with further amendment thereto by striking out Sec. 6 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof two new sections to be Secs. 6 and 7 to read:

Sec. 6. DEPARTMENT OF LIQUOR CONTROL REPORT

On or before January 15, 2015, the Commissioner of Liquor Control, in consultation with the Department of Health, shall submit a report to the Senate Committee on Economic Development, Housing and General Affairs, the House Committee on General, Housing and Military Affairs, the Senate Committee on Judiciary, and the House Committee on Judiciary regarding the risks associated with powdered alcohol products. The sale of and use of powdered alcohol products shall be illegal until the General Assembly passes a law regulating powdered alcohol products.

Sec. 7. EFFECTIVE DATES

- (a) This Sec. and Secs. 3, 4, and 6 shall take effect on passage.
- (b) Secs. 1, 2, and 5 shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
