



Full VAPHI Membership Requirements

- a) **Must have a minimum of 50 paid home inspections / invoice proof.**
- b) **New inspectors are welcome and are encouraged to attend meetings; they cannot be a full member until meeting all the requirements however. No website listing or VAPHI logo use until requirements are met.**
- c) **E&O insurance is required for all members, even applicants.**
- d) **Must declare what national Standard Operating Procedures and Code of Ethics will be used, NAHI, NACHI, ASHI, etc. Pledge to abide by them and use them in the most professional manner.**
- e) **Must have a minimum of 12 Continuing Educational Credits per year. Course curriculum accepted by a national H.I. organization or by at least one state. Also VAPHI educational meeting presentations by Professionals can be used as CE's.**
- f) **Proof of graduation from a comprehensive Home Inspection course / school, meaning all disciplines of home inspection should be represented in the training (example, HAVC, Structure, Plumbing, Electrical, etc). Course curriculum has to be accepted by at least one state in the country. Or if licensed in another state, the above requirements are waived.**
- g) **Must have passed a Home Inspection proctored test, accepted by at least one state in the country. Example the National Home Inspection Exam (N.H.I.E.) or equivalent, it is not limited to this entity.**
- h) **Must have a inspection agreement as a part of business plan.**
- i) **Must sign up for VAPHI Google Groups (on line discussion area for VAPHI members).**
- j) **Pay dues annually in January (\$150)**
- k) **Attend at least four meetings annually, participate / contribute to the group's mission.**
- l) **Members can be part time Inspectors.**
- m) **Proof all items above should be submitted to the secretary annually in January.**
