**Reach Up Client Data**

In the records of Reach Up clients who have been participating in Reach Up for longer than 60 months, the following data was retrieved in the fall, 2013. Over 175 long term Reach Up client files were carefully reviewed to support the work of the Reach Up work group.

Diagnosis in the record: 49% depression

23% PTSD

41% Anxiety

Treatment compliance: 49% completely complying

33% partially complying

18% non-compliant

Barriers to employment: 22% acknowledged substance abuse issue

59% acknowledged mental health issue

12% suspected substance abuse by case manager

Involvement with corrections: 23% of male heads of household in Reach Up also involved with DOC\*

15% of female heads of household in RU also involved with DOC\*

\*Point in time data match in 2012 or 2013.
