

**Immunization Rates for 2012-2013 School Year**  
**Albert D. Lawton**  
**2012-2013 School Year Enrollment: 344**

Immunizations are required for enrollment in all Vermont schools in order to prevent the spread of infectious diseases. The Vermont Legislature passed a requirement in May 2012, that all schools must make immunization rates for the student body available to the public. The Vermont Department of Health receives population-based immunization information from each Vermont school annually in January and reviews the data to ensure it is accurate.

The information below identifies the percent of students who have been fully vaccinated for each required vaccine. For purposes of comparison, the percent of all students enrolled in kindergarten and seventh grades who received the required vaccines is also presented for each vaccine.

<sup>i</sup> DTaP (diphtheria, tetanus and pertussis) - 5 doses, and Tdap (tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis) – 1 dose for 7<sup>th</sup> grade entry

<sup>ii</sup> Polio – 4 doses

<sup>iii</sup> MMR (measles, mumps and rubella) – 2 doses

<sup>iv</sup> Hep B – hepatitis B – 3 doses

<sup>v</sup> Varicella (chickenpox) – beginning in school year 2008-09 for grades K and 7<sup>th</sup>, 2 doses or documentation of history of disease

<sup>vi</sup> Fully Immunized – percent of students meeting all vaccine requirements
