Good Morning Tim:

Our history of lake level as measured by the elevation of the basement or lake level floor.

1. Prior to the dam reconstruction in 2004 the spring high water level exceeded the floor elevation by about 2-3 inches once every 2-3 years. The level was observed as water stains and debris on wood posts inside the basement with the doors closed. This level normally occurred prior to the opening of camp although we were there during one early spring to witness ice out etc. and witnessed the flooding
2. After the dam was rebuilt we observed flooding every year and the level of flood appeared to be 6-8 inches above floor level again as measured by the stains and debris on the wood posts. One flood was severe enough to damage the right hand doors.
3. In 2010 we had the concrete repaired (with permit) due to significant age deterioration. In the process we increased the elevation of the concrete floor by 7 inches at the lake side edge sloping upward to the rear to allow for drainage in the event of flooding. It still flood approximately 1-2 inches every year. We have resorted to heavy sand bagging to prevent damage to the doors and interior.
