

Act No. 38 (H.282). Professions and occupations; Office of Professional Regulation

An act relating to professions and occupations regulated by the Office of Professional Regulation

This act makes miscellaneous amendments to professions and occupations regulated by the Office of Professional Regulation. Aside from amending laws that generally apply to all professions and occupations the Office regulates, the act amends provisions of law regarding the following specific professions and occupations: property inspectors, nurses, osteopathic physicians, pharmacy, real estate brokers and salespersons, radiologic technicians, psychologists, social workers, clinical mental health counselors, audiologists, hearing aid dispensers, marriage and family therapists, rostered psychotherapists, electrologists, speech-language pathologists, and naturopathic physicians. In addition, the act requires the Office to license and regulate applied behavior analysts and creates two new Office positions.
