

No. R-118. House concurrent resolution congratulating Caitlin C. Gregg on winning a bronze medal at the FIS (International Ski Federation) Nordic World Ski Championships 2015.

Whereas, prior to 2015, an American woman had never won a medal at a major international Nordic ski race, and

Whereas, Caitlin Gregg started her role as a Nordic skier as a sophomore at Harwood Union High School, and

Whereas, since 2001, she has competed in Nordic skiing events on the national and international levels, and

Whereas, Caitlin Gregg was honored to be named to the 2010 U.S. Winter Olympics team and placed a respectable sixth overall in the team sprint with Kikkan Randall, and

Whereas, at the FIS Nordic World Ski Championships 2015 held in Falun, Sweden, she wrote a new page in the history of American women's international Nordic skiing competition, and

Whereas, Caitlin Gregg won a bronze medal in the 10-kilometer freestyle race, establishing a new milestone for American women Nordic skiers, now therefore be it

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives:

That the General Assembly congratulates Caitlin Gregg on winning a bronze medal at the FIS (International Ski Federation) Nordic World Ski Championships 2015, and be it further
