Subject: Human services; adult protective services; investigations; due  
process; confidentiality; immunity

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to improve  
safeguards for alleged perpetrators of the abuse, neglect, or exploitation of  
vulnerable adults. It would:

(1) require the alleged perpetrator of abuse, neglect, or exploitation to be  
notified of the nature of the allegations against him or her at the beginning of  
an adult protective services investigation, as well as of all evidence supporting  
the allegations prior to a finding that a report is substantiated or  
unsubstantiated;

(2) define the specific process for all investigations into allegations of  
abuse, neglect, and exploitation;

(3) require the Department of Disabilities, Aging, and Independent  
Living to develop, by rule, separate forms for the reporting of abuse, neglect,  
and exploitation by mandatory reporters and by other reporters;
