14 (d) A physician shall not be subject to any civil or criminal liability or  
15 professional disciplinary action for making a medical confirmation pursuant to  
16 subdivision 5283(a)(7) of this title.

17 (e) A pharmacist licensed pursuant to 26 V.S.A. chapter 36 shall not be  
18 subject to any civil or criminal liability or professional disciplinary action for  
19 dispensing medication prescribed pursuant to subdivision 5283(a)(13)(B) or  
20 5289(3) of this title.
