Subject: Highways; transportation; signs; idling

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require installation of signs on property owned or controlled by the State on which parking is permitted indicating that Vermont prohibits idling of motor vehicle engines in violation of law.

An act relating to signage on State property regarding unlawful idling of motor vehicle engines

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. INSTALLATION OF SIGNAGE REGARDING UNLAWFUL
IDLING OF MOTOR VEHICLE ENGINES

(a) On or before July 1, 2017, the Agency of Transportation shall oversee completion of a project to install signs on property owned or controlled by the State on which parking is permitted indicating that idling of motor vehicle engines in violation of 23 V.S.A. § 1110 is prohibited. At a minimum, at least one such sign shall be installed at each rest area, information center, park and

1 ride facility, parking structure, and building owned or controlled by the State
2 where parking is permitted.

3 (b) The Agency of Transportation shall be responsible for overseeing
4 ongoing maintenance of the signs required to be installed under subsection (a)
5 of this section, and for overseeing the installation of new signs as described in
6 subsection (a) of this section after July 1, 2017 if the State acquires control of
7 new property thereafter where parking is permitted.

8 (c) On or before January 15, 2017, the Secretary of Transportation or
9 designee shall report to the House and Senate Committees on Transportation
10 on the plans and progress in carrying out the signage installation project
11 required under subsection (a) of this section.

12 Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

13 This act shall take effect on passage.
