5 Subject: Health; food service establishments; occasional use

6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to require the  
7 Commissioner of Health to amend the definition of “occasional” in the  
8 Department’s rules on food service establishments to allow an unlicensed,  
9 charitable, nonprofit organization to serve food to the public four times a  
10 month not to exceed 12 times in a calendar year as opposed to once each  
11 month.

12 An act relating to the occasional use of food service establishments

13 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 Sec. 1. RULEMAKING

15 The Commissioner of Health shall amend the Department’s rules pertaining  
16 to food service establishments pursuant to 3 V.S.A. chapter 25 to define  
17 “occasional” as it pertains to registered charitable nonprofit organizations to  
18 mean not more than four times a month and not more than 12 days in total in  
19 any calendar year.

2       This act shall take effect on July 1, 2016.
