To Whom it May Concern:

In 2013, following the release of the 10th edition of IESNA Lighting Handbook, Efficiency Vermont and the Agency of Education jointly published a "K-12 Guide to School Lighting". See attached.

Key recommendations include specific strategies that:

- a) follow best practices to improve the quality of lighting for the benefit of students and teachers in the classroom;
- b) deploy control technologies that adjust light levels based on the type of instruction and the amount of daylight; and
- c) maximize energy efficiency according to IESNA recommendations through professional lighting design.

Through our RELIGHT program and our project incentives, and by following IESNA recommendations for best practices, Efficiency Vermont and its project partners can provide all Vermont public schools with the opportunity to achieve all three objectives.
