


# Teen Drivers Risk Death with Young Passengers

A 16- or 17-year-old driver's **RISK OF BEING KILLED IN A CRASH** increases when there are young passengers in the vehicle.

Compared to driving without any passengers, **THE RISK:**




**QUADRUPLES** when carrying  
3 or more passengers younger than 21



**DOUBLES** when carrying  
2 passengers younger than 21



**INCREASES** by 44 % when  
carrying 1 passenger younger than 21



**DECREASES** by 62 %  
when an adult age 35+ is in the vehicle
