Proposal

A victim in a delinquency proceeding involving crimes against a person shall have the following rights:

Upon the filing of a delinquency petition, the prosecutor's office shall notify a victim of his or her rights as provided by law, information on how a case proceeds through delinquency proceedings, the confidential nature of these proceedings and that it is unlawful for the victim to disclose confidential information to other persons.

To be notified by the prosecutor's office in a timely manner when a delinquency petition has been filed including the identity of the juvenile and any conditions of release that are materially-related to the victim, or intended to protect the safety of the victim.

To be notified by the prosecutor's office in a timely manner when a pre-dispositional or dispositional court proceeding is scheduled to take place and when a court proceeding of which he or she has been notified will not take place as scheduled.

The prosecutor's office shall keep the victim informed and consult with the victim throughout the delinquency proceedings.

To be present at the disposition hearing and present a victim's impact statement and the need for restitution pursuant to (need to include cite)

Upon request, to be notified by the agency having custody of the delinquent child before he or she is discharged from a secure or staff-secured residential facility including any conditions of release that are materially-related to the victim, or intended to protect the safety of the victim.
