The basic logic of the fee structure is the following:

- 1. An annual “Authority to Recommend Licensure” fee**—We spend a good deal of time working with programs to answer questions about ROPA regulations and providing information on the program throughout the year. Programs that are able to “recommend” candidates for licensure become accredited and this provides them with a benefit for recruiting and retaining students. This fee would serve as an annual fee.

**Proposal--\$1000**

- 2. New Program Initiation Fee**—When an institution proposes a new program a visit to the site is required. We suggest a fee to cover the preparation and review of the new proposal.

**Proposal--\$2000**

- 3. Visit Fee**—A typical ROPA review consists of a 4 hour preliminary meeting (about 4 weeks prior to the visit), a two-day on-site visit, and a follow-up report. A typical review team consists of 3-5 members of the field and 2 AOE representatives. Each (non-AOE) team member receives a \$100 stipend. There are additional mileage costs for the team to travel to the preliminary meeting and for Hotel and dinner for AOE staff on the visit. (Currently, the program only pays for food for the team, but no AOE staff. AOE staff are paid out of the EQ Budget).

**Proposal--\$1500**

- 4. Review Fee based upon number of program completers**—Another way to consider an institution’s ability to absorb the cost is to set the review fee based upon the number of program completers. Programs with larger number of completers typically are more complex, have more endorsements, and take more time to review.

**Proposal--\$25 per program completer**

- 5. Two-year Report Fee**—New and existing programs must submit a two-year progress report to the AOE. Review of this report and presentation of the report to the Standards Board takes considerable time. The Standards Board retains the option of not requiring a two-year report for programs that demonstrate excellence.

**Proposal--\$500**

On an annual basis, a program would be responsible for submitting only the **\$1000** authority to recommend licensure fee to the agency. A review is completed every seven years. On a review year this proposal would require the review fee (**\$25 per student who completes a program for the last seven years**) and the visit fee (**\$1500**). In the third year of a cycle, most programs will be required to submit a two-year report. This would be an additional **\$500**.

In this scenario, the total institutional cost over seven years would be \$10,570, or an average of about \$1500 annually. An additional fee would be incurred if the institution decided to initiate a new program.

Below is the best estimate of the costs per institution over the full seven-year cycle.

# Program estimate; this program has just enrolled its first cohort of seven students. It hopes to be in the neighborhood of 20-25 students per cohort in a short time. I have used 15 completers as an estimate.

This analysis does not include the new program initiation fee. Statewide, we would expect approximately 3 new program applications annually, resulting in \$6000 in additional revenue and the associated visit fees; however, this would likely vary from year to year. If we assumed \$6000 in new program initiation fees annually, this would result in additional revenue of \$42,000 over the course of a seven year cycle. For each new program, there is an automatic two-year review. Each two-year review has an associated \$500 fee, resulting in an additional \$1500 in revenue in years 3-7 of a cycle, or \$7500. The total revenue associated with new programs is estimated to be \$49,500.

**Total Revenue**

The total revenue of a seven year cycle with review fees based upon \$25 per completer would be \$265,325.

**Impact**

Assuming 1.0 FTE to cost \$60,000 (salary and benefits), over the course of a 7 year cycle, this would total \$420,000. The total program revenue would account for about 63% of the staffing costs.
