


# Tip 3: Gestures

  - 5 Finger Application Minimize


Sometimes text on websites is too small to read or click. In Safari there is a Zoom in gesture.


Tap Safari to open up a web browser.



Tap the small gray bar at the top of the page that says “Search or enter an address.”



Note: you may have other pages open in Safari. You can click the Blue “+” on the top of the browser to create a new tab, so you do not lose the current page.






Your keyboard will pop up. Enter the web address legislature.vermont.gov and hit the blue “Go” on your keyboard.

From the Legislative Homepage, place the tips of your thumb and index on the screen.







Spreading your thumb and index fingers apart, will zoom in on the content between them.

When you have reached a comfortable viewing size, lift your fingers from the iPad.

To zoom back out, place your thumb and index fingers on the screen apart from one another, and pinch them back together.



When you have multiple applications open, you can quickly switch between them by placing 4 fingers onto the iPad, and swiping.



You can also view all the applications that are running on your iPad. To do this, place 4 fingers on the iPad and swipe upwards.






You can scroll back and forth to view the applications that are running by dragging your index finger across the screen.



You can close an application by placing your finger on the middle of the application window, and swiping it upwards until it slides off the top of the screen.



To make an application full screen, swipe right or left to find the application you want to open then tap the center of the application's window.



To quickly return to the Home Screen when you are using an application, place all 5 fingers onto the iPad and pinch them together.
