He is now 18. She has been the one consistent support throughout our time raising our child. Her advice and connections have been invaluable. Vermont needs to do a better job supporting families and children adopted through DCF. These kids need help and they need it before they end up in jail. Fortunately, Easter Seals is available and providing ideas, resources and support. Ann is still helping us. Getting us information. Finding resources. Offering ideas. We aren't getting this type of help from anywhere else really. Please increase base funding for Post Permanency Services Program by \$300,000.
