2 Representatives Small of Winooski, Logan of Burlington, Cole of Hartford,
3 Durfee of Shaftsbury, McGill of Bridport, Mulvaney-Stanak of Burlington,
4 Sibilia of Dover, and Surprenant of Barnard moves that the House propose to
5 the Senate that the bill be amended as follows:

6 First: In Sec. 3, 24 V.S.A. § 4413, in subdivision (a)(1), by striking out
7 subdivision (G) and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

8 (G) emergency shelters that include sleeping quarters and bathrooms
9 and are staffed by trained personnel who can provide wraparound support to
10 those receiving services.

11 Second: By striking out Sec. 47, effective dates, in its entirety and inserting
12 in lieu thereof there following:

13 Sec. 47. EFFECTIVE DATES

14 This act shall take effect on July 1, 2023, except that:

15 (1) Secs. 1 (24 V.S.A. § 4414) and 2 (24 V.S.A. § 4412) shall take effect
16 on December 1, 2024, except for subdivision (1)(D) of Sec. 2, which shall take
17 effect on July 1, 2023.

18 (2) Sec. 3 (24 V.S.A. § 4413) shall take effect on September 1, 2023.

19 (3) Sec. 46 (lead inspectors) shall take effect on passage.
