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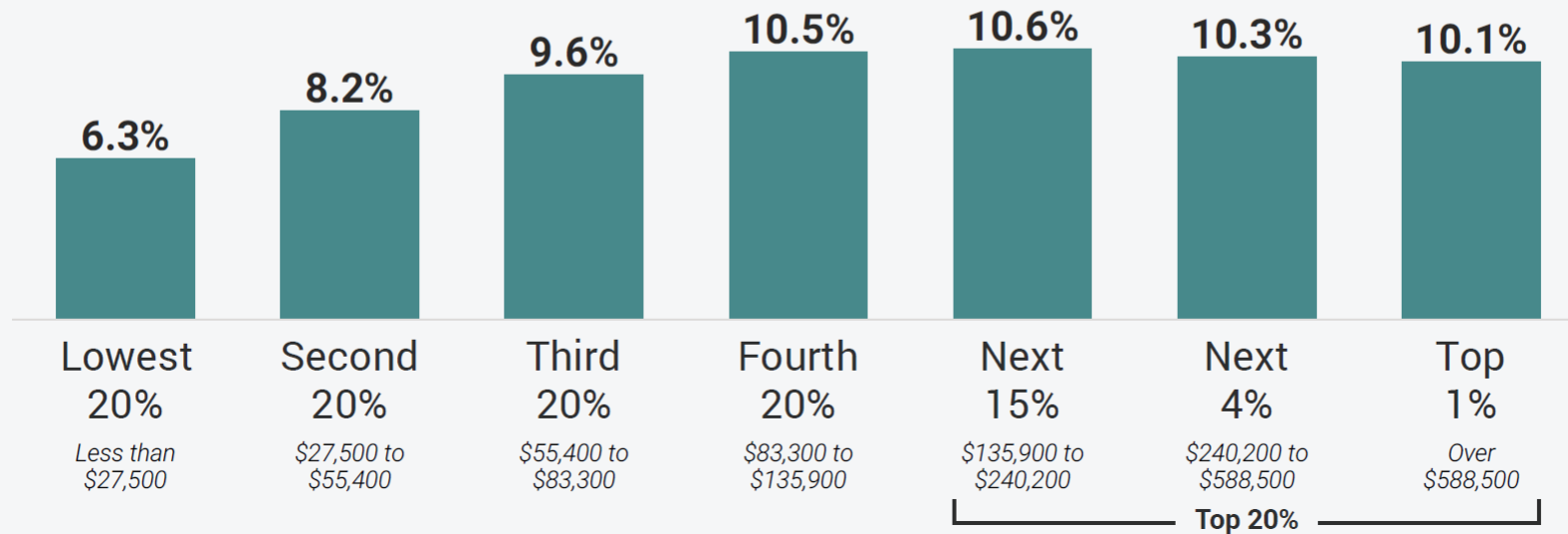

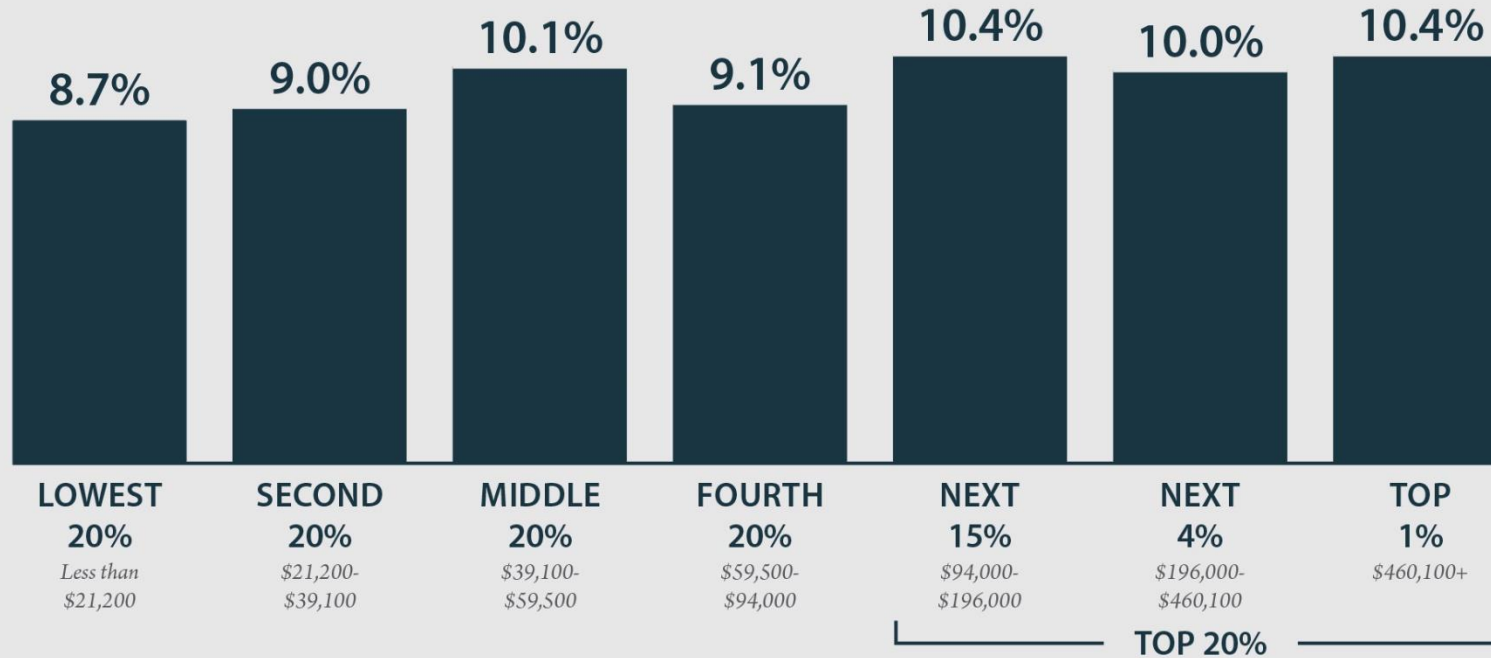

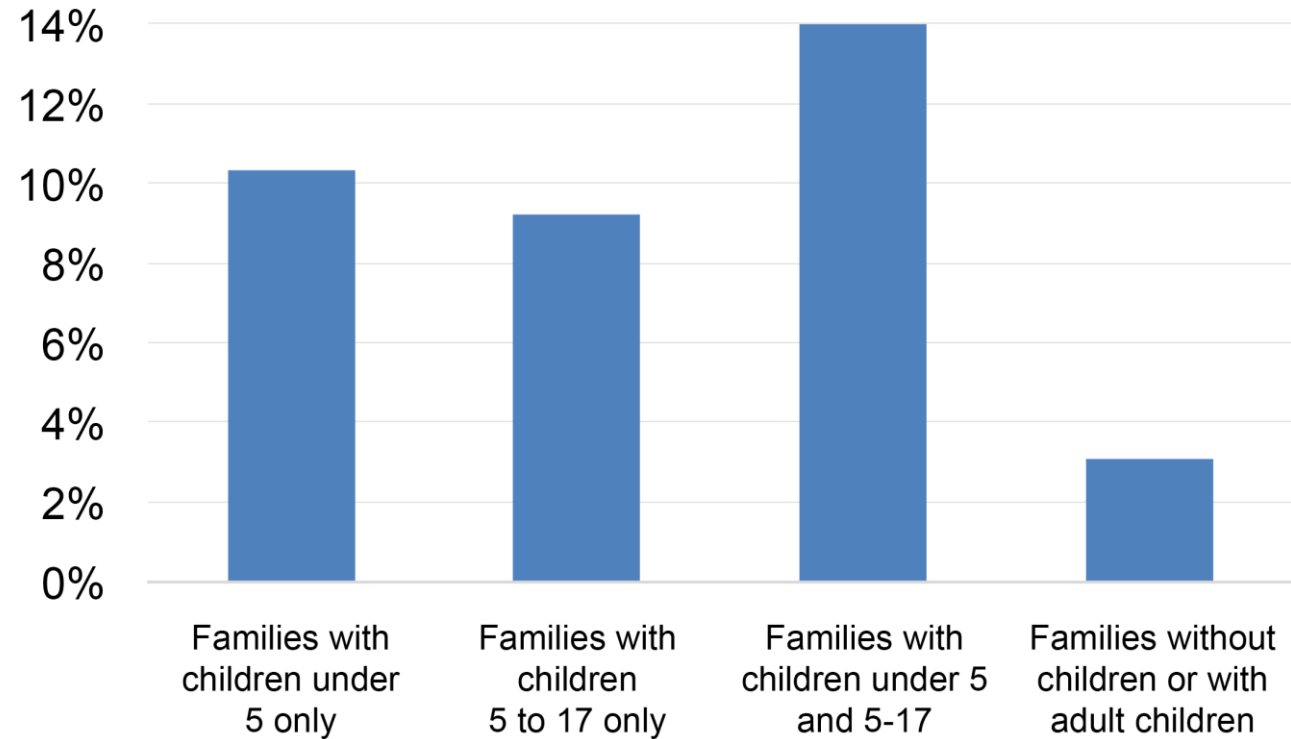

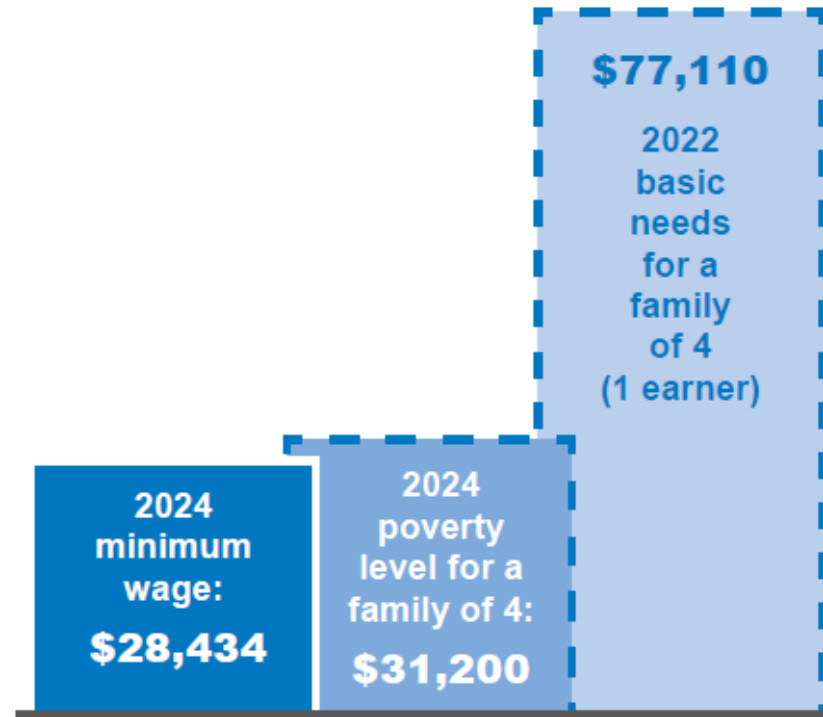
Vermont families with children are more likely to live in poverty

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Minimum wage leaves families in poverty, and far from meeting basic needs

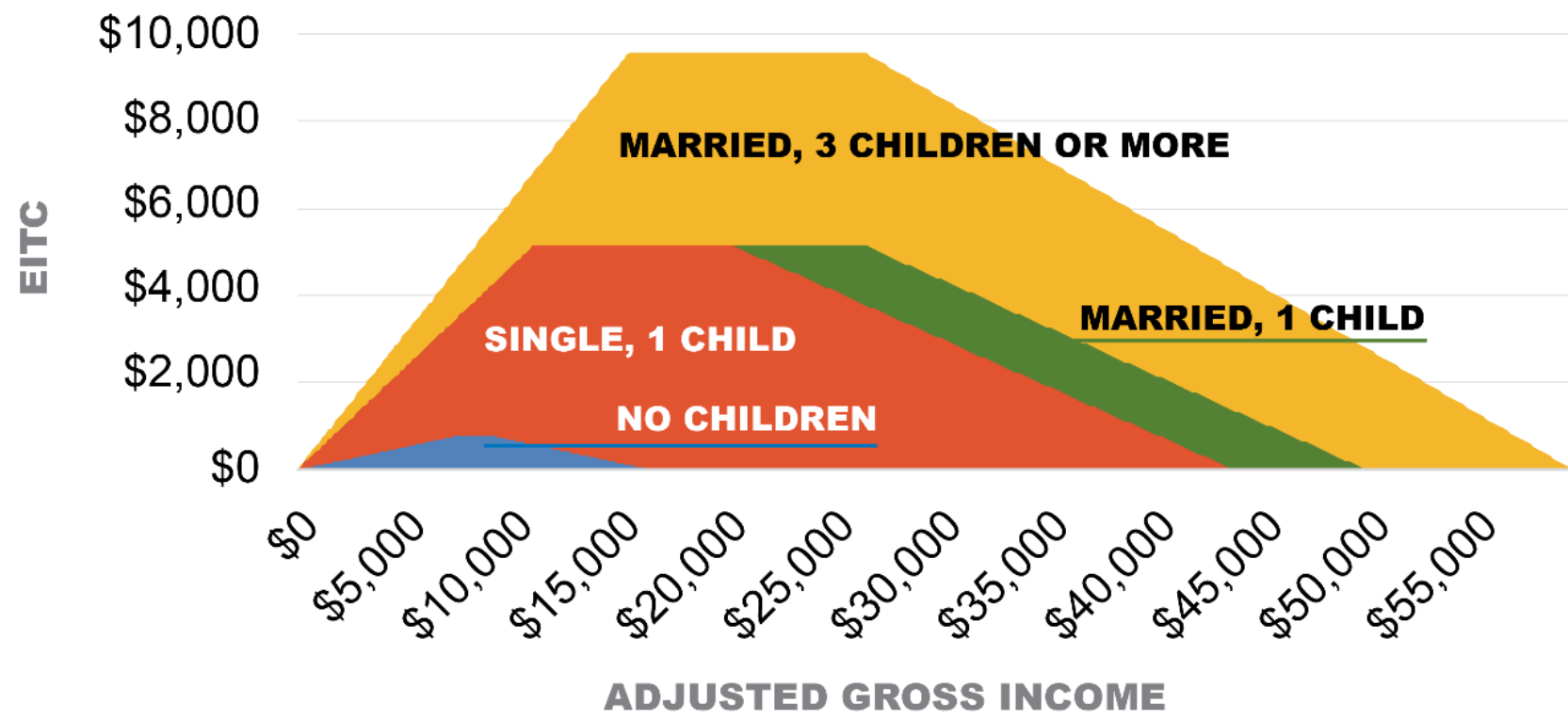
