Department of Fish and Wildlife FY24/25 Capital Budget Total Governor Recommend

Improving Public Access to Wildlife Management Areas and Maintaining critical management infrastructure: \$354,150

Access Area Infrastructure Improvements: \$750,000

Infrastructure Maintenance/Improvement of Fish and Wildlife Buildings including Conservation Camps: \$1,315,000

Hatchery Improvements: \$1,977,700

Shooting Range Improvements: \$226,132

Forest, Parks & Recreation FY24/25 Capital Budget Total Governor Recommend

Infrastructure Rehabilitation and Improvement: \$6.5M

Replacement Park Maintenance Facilities at Gifford Woods (Killington) and Groton: \$3M

3-Acre Rule Compliance: \$500,000

Open Access Recreational Infrastructure: \$600,000

Implement Best Management Practices at State Forests and Recreational Access Points: \$468,863

Forest Park Access Road: \$370,000

Clean Water Initiative (Interagency) FY24/25 Capital Budget Total Governor Recommend: \$15.9M

Exceeds Clean Water Board FY24 Request of \$10M

DEC

- State 20% match for Base federal Clean Water State Revolving Fund capitalization grants: \$332,981
- Municipal Pollution Control Grants: \$10M

Forestry Access Road Water Quality Improvements: \$550,000

AAFM Water Quality Grants: \$2.2M

VHCB

- Land Conservation and Water Quality Projects: \$2M
- Agricultural Water Quality Projects: \$800,000

State 20% match for Base federal Drinking Water State Revolving Fund capitalization grants: \$174,586


State 20% match for Supplemental federal (BIL/IIJA) State Revolving Fund capitalization grants: \$27M
