HWAP Funded WAP Projects Only -- Weatherization Affordable Rent Levels

In some cases, program eligibilty can be established when the rent level for the dwelling units are Weatherization Affordable. This means that the "rent"* is set at a level representing less than 30% of a household's income, assuming a household earning of 80% AMI or SMI. This year AMI is used in Addison, Chittenden, Franklin & Grand Isle Counties for this calculation. SMI is used in this calculation for the other 10 Vermont Counties.

Prioritization for service should be given to dwellings with rent levels set at a level that represents less than 30% of a household's income, assuming a household earning of 60% AMI or SMI.

Using

Weatherization Affordable Rent Levels to establish program eligibility is only allowable for dwelling units within 5(+) unit **buildings**.

*The amount of rent <u>must</u> include the cost of (a) rent <u>plus</u> (b) utilities.

This does not mean that dwelling units where the tenant pays for their own utilities cannot be rent qualified. It means that the sum of the rent paid to the property owner <u>plus</u> tenant costs paid directly to utilities must be less than 30% of household income, assuming 80% AMI or SMI as the household income level. This is represented in the Table 3 figures above.
