Subject: Motor vehicles; driver license; anatomical gifts

Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to require the department of motor vehicles to provide the option for the holders of a standard or commercial driver license to have an anatomical gift donation indicated on the license.

AN ACT RELATING TO INDICATING ANATOMICAL GIFTS ON A
DRIVER LICENSE

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 618a is added to read:

§ 618a. ANATOMICAL GIFT ACT; DONOR; FORM

The commissioner shall provide a form which, upon the licensee's execution, shall serve as a document of an anatomical gift under chapter 109 of Title 18. An indicator shall be place on the license of any person who has executed an anatomical gift form in accordance with this section.

(a) Contents of license. A commercial driver license shall be marked "commercial driver license" or "CDL," and shall be, to the maximum extent practicable, tamper proof, and shall include, but not be limited to, the following information:

(11) An indicator that a licensee has executed a document that serves as an anatomical gift pursuant to section 618a of this title.
