| 15 | It is unlawful to sell or offer for sale use a lead sinker in all inland lakes or |
| 16 | ponds within the state of Vermont. <u>Lead sinkers may be used in streams and</u> |
| 17 | rivers within the state of Vermont. In this section, "sinker" means any device |
| 18 | which weighs one-half ounce or less and is attached to a fishing line for the |
