18	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:		

- 19 Sec. 1. SHORT TITLE
- 20 This bill shall be known as the "Snelling Surcharge."

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1	Sec. 2.	SURTAX RATES

- 2 (a) For taxable years beginning between January 1, 2009 and December 31,
- 3 <u>2011, there is imposed a surtax on the amount of tax imposed under section</u>
- 4 <u>5822 of Title 32, determined without regard to any available income tax</u>
- 5 <u>credits</u>, as follows: a surtax of three percent of the taxpayer's state tax liability
- 6 <u>if the taxpayer's taxable income is between \$46,700.00 and \$171,950.00</u>,
- 7 <u>inclusive; a surtax of six percent of the taxpayer's state tax liability if the</u>
- 8 <u>taxpayer's taxable income is between \$171,950.01 and \$307,050.00, inclusive;</u>
- 9 and a surtax of nine percent of the taxpayer's state tax liability if the taxpayer's
- 10 <u>taxable income is greater than \$307,050.00; provided, however, that these</u>
- 11 dollar amounts shall be adjusted each year in accordance with the provisions of
- 12 <u>32 V.S.A. § 5822(b)(2).</u>
- 13 (b) Of the revenue collected pursuant to this surtax, the first \$20 million
- 14 <u>collected in each tax year shall be deposited into the revenue shortfall reserve</u>

- 16 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
- 17 <u>This act shall take effect upon passage.</u>
