of at least \$25,000.00 for one person and \$50,000.00 for two or more persons

- 17 In lieu thereof, evidence of self-insurance in the amount of \$115,000.00 must
- 18 be filed with the commissioner of motor vehicles. <u>This provision shall permit</u>
- 19 <u>an organization to post a bond on behalf of an owner of a motor vehicle who</u>
- 20 <u>chooses to self-insure.</u> Such financial responsibility shall be maintained and

- 1 evidenced in a form prescribed by the commissioner. The commissioner may
- 2 require that evidence of financial responsibility be produced before motor
- 3 vehicle inspections are performed pursuant to the requirements of section 1222
