14	Subject: Taxation; income tax; education property tax; sales and use tax
15	Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to provide relief for elderly
16	taxpayers. The bill would:
17	(1) Lower the homestead property tax base rate for homestead declarants
18	above age 65 by a small percentage, such percentage to increase every few
19	years so that as a homestead declarant becomes older, his or her homestead
20	education property tax rate would become lower.

1	(2) Create tax credits for people over age 65 so that as an individual
2	taxpayer becomes older, he or she becomes eligible for an increasing amount
3	of tax credits.
4	(3) Provide the elderly with certain targeted exemptions from the sales and
5	use taxes such that as an individual becomes older, he or she is eligible for
6	either a higher percentage of sales and use tax exemption or is eligible for a
7	broader number of categories of items for which he or she will be exempt from
8	paying sales and use taxes.
