5	Subject: Motor vehicles; super speeders; violations; interstate highways; point
6	system; enhanced penalty; traumatic brain injury fund
7	Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to:
8	(1) extend to interstate highways the statutory point system penalties
9	imposing incrementally higher points for different degrees of speeding; and
10	(2) impose an enhanced penalty for "super speeders" adjudged of operating
11	more than 20 miles per hour in excess of the speed limit, with the proceeds to
12	benefit the Vermont traumatic brain injury fund.
13	An act relating to extending to interstate highways incrementally higher
14	point system penalties for different degrees of speeding and imposing
15 16	enhanced penalties on super speeders with proceeds to benefit the Vermont traumatic brain injury fund
17	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
18	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 2502 is amended to read:
19	§ 2502. POINT ASSESSMENT; SCHEDULE
20	(a) Any person operating a motor vehicle shall have points assessed against
21	his or her driving record for convictions for moving violations of the indicated

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motor vehicle statutes in accord with the following schedule:	(All references
are to Title 23 of the Vermont Statutes Annotated.)	

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- (6) Two points assessed for sections 1003 (state speed zones), 1004 (interstate highway rules), and 1007. State speed zones and local speed limits, more than (local speed limits) for violations of less than 10 miles per hour over and in excess of the speed limit.
- (7) Three points assessed for sections 1003 (state speed zones), 1004 (interstate highway rules), and 1007. State speed zones and local speed limits, more than (local speed limits) for violations of 10 to 20 miles per hour over and in excess of the speed limit.
- (8) Five points assessed for sections 1003 (state speed zones), 1004 (interstate highway rules), and 1007. State speed zones and local speed limits, more than 20 (local speed limits) for violations of 21 to 30 miles per hour over and in excess of the speed limit.
- (9) Eight points assessed for sections 1003 (state speed zones), 1004 (interstate highway rules), and 1007. State speed zones and local speed limits, (local speed limits) for violations of more than 30 miles per hour over and in excess of the speed limit.

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2	§ 1007b. SUPER SPEEDER VIOLATION; ENHANCED PENALTY
3	(a) In addition to any other fines or penalties imposed for violations of
4	section 1003 (state speed zones), 1004 (interstate highway rules), 1007 (local
5	speed limits), or 1081 (basic rule and maximum limits) of this title, the
6	department of motor vehicles shall administer and collect a fee of \$200.00
7	from any driver adjudged of a violation of more than 20 miles per hour over
8	the speed limit (hereafter "super speeder violation").
9	(b) Within 30 days of judgment of a super speeder violation, the
10	department of motor vehicles shall send notice of imposition of the fee
11	specified in subsection (a) of this section by first-class mail to the address of
12	the offender shown in the records of the department. The notice shall state that
13	failure to pay the fee within 30 days of the date of the notice shall result in
14	suspension of the offender's operator's license or privilege to operate, and the
15	denial, if the offender is the sole registrant, of the offender's application for
16	renewal of a motor vehicle registration until the amount due is paid or
17	otherwise satisfied. If the offender fails to pay the amount due within the 30
18	days and the case is not pending on appeal, the judicial bureau shall provide
19	electronic notice to the commissioner of motor vehicles who, after 20 days
20	from the date of receiving the electronic notice, shall suspend the offender's
21	operator's license or privilege to operate and deny, if the offender is the sole

1	registrant, the offender's application for renewal of a motor vehicle registration
2	until the amount due is paid or otherwise satisfied.
3	(c) The department of motor vehicles shall be authorized to adopt rules to
4	implement the provisions of this section.
5	(d) All fees collected under this section shall be deposited in the Vermont
6	traumatic brain injury fund established by 33 V.S.A. § 7801. The office of the
7	state treasurer shall separately account for all the moneys received and
8	collected under this section.
