15	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:	
16	Sec. 1. 32 V.S.A. § 5827 is added to read:	
17	§ 5827. TAX CREDIT FOR ACTIVE DUTY MILITARY MEMBERS	
18	SERVING OVERSEAS	
19	A taxpayer of this state shall receive a refundable credit against the tax	
20	imposed under section 5822 of this title equal to \$500.00 if, during the tax	

1	year, the taxpayer served on active duty in a branch of the armed services and
2	was deployed overseas for a period of not less than 30 days during the tax year.
3	Sec. 2. IMPLEMENTATION
4	The commissioner of taxes shall work with the adjutant general to develop a
5	means of verifying the eligibility of any taxpayer claiming the credit provided
6	for in 32 V.S.A. § 5827.
7	Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE
8	This act shall take effect upon passage and shall apply to tax years
9	beginning on or after January 1, 2010.
