Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to reduce the number of board  
members on the community high school of Vermont board from nine to seven.

An act relating to reducing the number of board members on the community  
high school of Vermont board

1 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

2 Sec. 1. 28 V.S.A. § 121(b) is amended to read:

3 (b) The board shall consist of ~~nine~~ seven members, each appointed by the  
4 governor for a three-year term subject to the advice and consent of the senate,  
5 in such a manner that no more than three terms shall expire annually, as  
6 follows:

7 (1) ~~Six~~ Five representatives from the membership of local advisory  
8 boards serving the school sites, not to include more than one member from any  
9 advisory board.

10 (2) ~~Three~~ Two members-at-large.
