If the voters have begun consideration of another article, the 17 original article may only be submitted to the voters at a subsequent annual or 18 special meeting duly warned for the purpose and called by the legislative body 19 on its own motion or pursuant to a petition requesting such reconsideration or 20 rescission signed and submitted in accordance with subsection (b) of this
