| 2  | It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:             |
| 3  | Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 304(j) is amended to read:                                    |
| 4  | (j) The commissioner of motor vehicles shall, upon proper application,            |
| 5  | issue special plates to Vermont veterans, as defined in 38 U.S.C. § 101(2), for   |
| 6  | use only on vehicles registered at the pleasure car rate and on trucks registered |
| 7  | for less than 26,001 pounds and excluding vehicles registered under the           |
| 8  | International Registration Plan. The type and style of the veterans' plate shall  |
| 9  | be determined by the commissioner, except that an American flag, or a             |
| 10 | veteran- or military-related emblem selected by the commissioner and the          |
| 11 | Vermont office of veterans' affairs shall appear on one side of the plate. At a   |
| 12 | minimum, emblems shall be available to recognize recipients of the Purple         |
| 13 | Heart, Pearl Harbor survivors, former prisoners of war, and disabled veterans.    |
| 14 | The commissioner shall, upon proper application, issue special plates to          |
| 15 | Vermont veterans for use on vehicles registered at the motorcycle rate. The       |
