6 Subject: Municipal government; municipal charters; amendment; city of

8 Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to approve an amendment to the
9 charter of the city of Rutland that would require municipal employees to pay
10 for 20 percent of their basic health care premium cost and 100 percent of any
11 enhancements to the basic premium.

12 An act relating to approval of an amendment to the charter of the city of
13 Rutland concerning municipal employee contributions to health care costs

14 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

15 Sec. 1. CHARTER APPROVAL

16 The general assembly approves the amendment to the city of Rutland
17 charter as provided in this act. The proposal of amendment was approved by
18 the voters on March 2, 2010.

1 Sec. 2. 24 App. V.S.A. chapter 9 § 11.3 is amended to read:

2 § 11.3. CITY BUDGET

3 (a) The mayor shall annually on or before the first Monday in each June,
4 prepare an estimate of the necessary appropriations to operate all departments
5 and branches of the city government except the board of school
6 commissioners. This budget shall be submitted to the board of aldermen for
7 their guidance and action in making the annual appropriations and the tax levy.
8 The board of aldermen may reduce the items of such budget but shall not
9 increase it.

10 (b) All participants of any city health care plan shall annually contribute a
11 minimum of 20 percent of the basic health care premium cost in addition to
12 100 percent of any enhancements to the basic premium. Contributions shall
13 take effect on the date of ratification by the general assembly.

14 Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

15 This act shall take effect upon passage.
