15	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
16	Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1129(a) is amended to read:
17	(a) The operator of a motor vehicle involved in an accident whereby a
18	person is injured or whereby there is total damage to all property to the extent
19	of \$1,000.00 or more shall make a written report concerning the accident to the

commissioner of motor vehicles on forms furnished by the commissioner. The

written report shall be mailed to the commissioner within 72 hours after the

1	accident. The commissioner may require further facts concerning the accident
2	to be provided upon forms furnished by him or her. Absent a conviction for
3	negligent or gross negligent operation, the provisions of this section shall not
4	apply to an on-duty law enforcement officer, firefighter, or emergency medical
5	personnel.
