to the date of the wine or malt beverage tasting event and the applicant is

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1 determined to be in good standing, the department of liquor control may grant 2 a permit to conduct a wine or malt beverage tasting event to: * * * 3 4 (3) A licensed manufacturer or rectifier of vinous beverages with a 5 fourth class or farmers' market license. The licenses authorize the licensee to 6 dispense, with or without charge, vinous beverages and fortified wines that 7 have been manufactured by the licensee, by the glass, not to exceed two ounces 8 per product and a total of eight ounces to a retail customer of legal age for 9 consumption on the licensee's premises or at a farmers' market. * * * 10 11
