An act relating to processing the application for motor vehicle emergency light permits

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 23 V.S.A. § 1251 is amended to read:

## § 1251. SIRENS AND COLORED SIGNAL LAMPS

No A motor vehicle shall <u>not</u> be operated upon a highway of this state equipped with a siren or signal lamp colored other than amber unless a permit authorizing <u>such</u> this equipment, issued by the commissioner of motor vehicles, is carried in the vehicle. A permit may be transferred following the <u>same procedure and subject to the same time limits as set forth in section 321 of this title.</u> The commissioner may adopt additional rules as may be required to govern the acquisition of permits and the use pertaining to sirens and colored signal lamps.

## Sec. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
