Senate Proposal of Amendment

S. 92

An act relating to the protection of students' health by requiring the use of safe cleaning products in schools

The Senate concurs in the House proposal of amendment with further proposal of amendment thereto:

<u>First</u>: In Sec. 1a, 18 V.S.A. § 1781, by striking out subdivision (7) in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof the following:

(7) "Green cleaning" means a practice that includes:

(A) the use of a cleaning product certified as environmentally preferable by an independent third party or an environmentally preferable cleaning product used by the department of buildings and general services;

(B) best practices that follow accepted management standards and improve indoor air quality; and

(C) equipment that facilitates effective cleaning.

Second: In Sec. 1a, 18 V.S.A. § 1782, by adding a new subsection (d) to read as follows:

(d) A distributor or manufacturer of cleaning products shall provide a green cleaning training to each school district it provides with environmentally preferable cleaning products, provided the training is incurred at no cost to the school district.

<u>Third</u>: In Sec. 1a, 18 V.S.A. chapter 39, by adding a new section § 1784 to read as follows:

§ 1784. PENALTY EXEMPTION

Nothing in this chapter shall cause a person to be subject to the fine established in section 7 of this title.

<u>Second</u>: In Sec. 2, subdivision (2), by striking both references to "2012" and inserting in lieu thereof "2013"

<u>Third</u>: In Sec. 4 (Effective Date), by striking "2011" and inserting in lieu thereof "2012"

Public Hearing on Fiscal Year 2012 Budget Adjustment Room: 10, State House House Committee on Appropriation

Deadline for Introducing Bills

Pursuant to Rule 40(b) of the Rules and Orders of the Vermont House of Representatives, during the second year of the biennium, except with the prior consent of the Committee on Rules, no member may introduce a bill into the House drafted in standard form after the last day of January. Bills may be introduced in Short Form until the second Friday after Town Meeting Day.

In order to meet this deadline all bills must be signed out with the Legislative Council no later than the close of business on Tuesday, January 17, 2012. Requests for short form bills may be made until Wednesday, February 15, 2012.

Pursuant to Rule 40(c) during the second year of the biennium, except with the prior consent of the Committee on Rules, no committee, except the Committees on Appropriations, Ways and Means or Government Operations, may introduce a bill drafted in standard form after the last day of March. The Committees on Appropriations, Ways and Means bills may be drafted in standard form at any time, and Government Operations bills, pertaining to city or town charter changes, may be drafted in standard form at any time.
