

Act No. 162 (S.168). Municipal government

An act relating to making miscellaneous amendments to laws governing municipalities

This act makes a number of changes to statutes relating to municipal government. It allows a municipality to vote to have the collector of delinquent taxes appointed, rather than elected. It provides that a cemetery commissioner may not be a town treasurer. It permits the appointment of alternates to municipal planning commissions. It permits a town to require that a building's 911 address be posted and visible from the road. Finally, it adds a process by which a town official, during a state of emergency, can order an unsafe structure condemned to be destroyed.
