6	Statement of purpose: This bill proposes to repeal certain authority of the
7	Agency of Natural Resources to seek reimbursement of Agency costs from an
8	applicant for a permit, license, certification, or order issued under a program
9	that the Secretary of Natural Resources enforces.
10	An act relating to reimbursement of Agency of Natural Resources costs
11	It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:
12	Sec. 1. 3 V.S.A. § 2809 is amended to read:
13	§ 2809. REIMBURSEMENT OF AGENCY COSTS
14	(a)(1) The secretary Secretary may require an applicant for a permit,
15	license, certification, or order issued under a program that the secretary
16	Secretary enforces under 10 V.S.A. § 8003(a) to pay for the cost of research,

scientific, programmatic, or engineering expertise provided by or services that

the agency of natural resources, provided:

- (A) the secretary Agency of Natural Resources does not have when such expertise or services and such expertise is are required for the processing of the application for the permit, license, certification, or order; or
- (B) the secretary does have such expertise but has made a determination that it is beyond the agency's internal capacity to effectively utilize that expertise to process the application for the permit, license, certification, or order. In addition, the secretary shall determine that such expertise is required for the processing of the application for the permit, license, certification, or order.
- (2) The secretary Secretary may require an applicant under 10 V.S.A. chapter 151 of Title 10 to pay for the time of agency of natural resources

 Agency of Natural Resources personnel providing research, scientific, or engineering services or for the cost of expert witnesses when agency Agency personnel or expert witnesses are required for the processing of the permit application.
- (3) In addition to the authority Except as set forth under 10 V.S.A. chapters 59 and 159 of Title 10 and 10 V.S.A. § 1283, the secretary Secretary may require a person who caused the agency Agency to incur expenditures or a person in violation of a permit, license, certification, or order issued by the secretary Secretary to pay for the time of agency Agency personnel or the cost of other research, scientific, or engineering services incurred by the agency

1	Agency in response to a threat to public health or the environment presented by
2	an emergency or exigent circumstance.

- (b) Prior to commencing or contracting for research, scientific, or engineering expertise or services or contracting for expert witnesses for which the secretary Secretary intends to seek cost reimbursement under subdivisions (a)(1) and (2) of this section, the secretary Secretary shall notify the applicant for a permit, license, certification, or order of the secretary's Secretary's authority to assess costs under this section.
- (c)(1) Within 15 days of issuance of notice under subsection (b) of this section, an applicant for a permit, license, certification, or order may request a meeting with the secretary Secretary to identify and review the proposed agency Agency services or contracting services that may be assessed to the applicant.
- (2) The secretary Secretary may enter into agreements with an applicant for a permit, license, certification, or order under which either the applicant or the agency of natural resources Agency of Natural Resources shall provide or pay for the necessary research, scientific, or engineering expertise or services or expert witnesses.
- (3) When the <u>secretary Secretary</u> meets with an applicant under this subsection, the <u>secretary Secretary</u> shall provide the applicant in writing a preliminary estimate of the costs to be assessed and the purpose of the funds.

1	In the case of requests to pay costs under subdivision (a)(1)(B) of this section,
2	the secretary shall be limited to a reimbursement of not more than \$50,000.00.
3	(d) The following apply to the authority established under subsection (a) of
4	this section:
5	(1)(A) The Secretary may assess costs under subdivisions (a)(1) and (2)
6	of this section to the applicant or applicants for a permit, license, certification,
7	or order only with the approval of the Governor. Costs assessed under
8	subdivision (a)(3) of this section shall not require approval of the Governor.
9	(2) The secretary Secretary may require reimbursement only of costs in
10	excess of \$3,000.00 except as provided in subdivision (B) of this subdivision
11	(1) .
12	(B) Where the secretary has requested reimbursement of
13	programmatic expertise pursuant to subdivision (a)(1)(B) of this section. The
14	secretary may require reimbursement only of costs in excess of \$3,000.00 or
15	one half of the permit application fee assessed under section 2822 of this title,
16	whichever is greater.
17	(2)(3) The secretary Secretary may revise estimates previously noticed
18	as necessary from time to time during the progress of the work and shall notify
19	the applicant in writing of any revision.
20	(3)(4) The secretary Secretary shall provide the applicant with a detailed
21	statement of a final assessment under this section showing the total amount of

3	(4)(5) All funds collected from applicants shall be paid into the state
4	treasury State Treasury.
5	(e) The secretary Secretary may withhold a permit approval or suspend the
5	processing of a permit application for failure to pay reasonable costs imposed
7	under this subsection.
3	(f) An action or determination of the secretary Secretary under this section
