Subject: Alcoholic beverages; licensing; restrictions

Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow an employee of an alcoholic beverage wholesale dealer also to be employed by a first or second class licensee.

An act relating to employees of alcoholic beverage wholesale dealers

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 230 is amended to read:

§ 230. RESTRICTIONS; FINANCIAL INTERESTS; DISPLAY OF  
LICENSE; EMPLOYEES

\* \* \*

(b) An individual who is an employee of a wholesale dealer that does not hold a solicitor's permit may also be employed by a first or second class licensee on a paid or voluntary basis, provided that the employee does not exercise any control over, or participate in, the management of the first or second class licensee's business or business decisions, and that either employment relationship does not result in the exclusion of any competitor

1 wholesale dealer or any brand of alcoholic beverages of a competitor

2 wholesale dealer.
