## SENATE PROPOSAL OF AMENDMENT

## H. 280

An act relating to payment of wages

The Senate proposes to the House to amend the bill as follows:

<u>First</u>: In Sec. 1, 21 V.S.A. § 341, in subdivision (5), by striking out the word "<u>bonuses</u>" and inserting in lieu thereof <u>incentive pay</u>

<u>Second</u>: By striking Sec. 2 in its entirety and inserting in lieu thereof a new Sec. 2 to read:

Sec. 2. 21 V.S.A. § 342 is amended to read:

## § 342. WEEKLY PAYMENT OF WAGES

- (a)(1) Any person employer having one or more employees doing and transacting business within the state State shall pay each week, in lawful money or checks, the wages earned by each employee to a day not more than six days prior to the date of such payment.
- (2) After giving written notice to the <u>employee or</u> employees, any <u>person employer</u> having <u>an employee or</u> employees doing and transacting business within the <u>state State</u> may, notwithstanding subdivision (1) of this subsection, pay biweekly or semimonthly in lawful money or checks; each employee the wages earned by the employee to a day not more than six days prior to the date of the payment. If a collective bargaining agreement so

provides, the payment may be made to a day not more than 13 days prior to the date of payment.

<u>Third</u>: In Sec. 3, 21 V.S.A. § 342a, in subsection (f), by inserting a sentence at the end of the subsection to read: <u>The costs of transcription shall be paid by the requesting party.</u>
