10	Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to make a ski
11	area liable to a rescue organization for the costs the organization incurs
12	rescuing a person who skis off the ski area's designated trails. The ski area is
13	permitted to impose a surcharge on lift tickets to defray the rescue costs.

1	(c) Civil action to recover. A person who uses the facilities of a ski area to
2	access terrain outside the open and designated ski trails, shall be liable in a
3	civil action brought by any person, including a ski area, rescue organization,
4	municipality, or the state State, to recover expenses incurred to provide rescue,
5	medical, or other services to such person for circumstances or injuries which
6	resulted from such use. The entity seeking to recover may also recover
7	reasonable attorney's fees and court costs. No Except as provided in
8	subsection (d) of this section, no ski area, its owners, agents or employees,
9	individual or entity, municipal or otherwise, shall be held liable for any acts or
10	omissions taken in the course of such rescue operations unless such act or
11	omission constitutes gross negligence.
12	(d)(1) A ski area shall be liable to a rescue organization for the costs the
13	organization incurs rescuing a person who uses the facilities of a ski area to
14	access terrain outside the ski area's open and designated ski trails. A rescue
15	organization that prevails in an action to enforce this subsection shall be
16	entitled to recover costs, including reasonable attorney's fees, from the ski
17	area.
18	(2) A ski area may impose a surcharge on lift tickets to defray the costs
19	of reimbursing rescue organizations for rescuing persons who use the ski area's

facilities to access terrain outside the ski area's open and designated ski trails.
