13 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

14 Sec. 1. CHARTER AMENDMENT APPROVAL

15 The General Assembly approves an amendment to the charter of the
16 Winooski Incorporated School District as set forth in this act. Proposals of
17 amendment were approved by the voters on March 5, 2013.

18 Sec. 2. 16 App. V.S.A. chapter 23 is amended to read:

19 CHAPTER 23. WINOOSKI INCORPORATED SCHOOL DISTRICT

§ 3. ANNUAL DISTRICT MEETING

The annual district meeting shall be held on the first Tuesday of March and the immediate preceding Monday as follows:

(1) Monday: At 7:30 p.m. at a place to be selected by the ~~board of trustees~~ Board of Trustees. The ~~moderator~~ Moderator shall convene the annual district meeting with the following agenda:

(A) The district shall elect a moderator, and clerk, ~~and treasurer~~, the term of office to start July 1.

(2) Tuesday: The voters shall at this continued annual district meeting, to be held on the first Tuesday in March from seven o'clock in the forenoon to seven o'clock in the afternoon and conducted at the same place and manner as the annual meeting of the ~~city~~ City of Winooski (Appendix A):

(D) Elect a school district treasurer for a term of three years whose duties, authority, and responsibilities shall be those established by law.

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Sec. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This act shall take effect on passage.
