16	(5) "Tobacco license" means a license issued by the Department of

18	the licensee to engage in the retail sale of tobacco products or locate a vending	
19	machine on the premises identified in the license.

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§ 1002. LICENSE REQUIRED; APPLICATION; FEE; ISSUANCE

(a) No person shall engage in the retail sale of tobacco products, tobacco substitutes, or tobacco paraphernalia or provide a vending machine for their sale in his or her place of business without a tobacco license obtained from the Department of Liquor Control legislative body of the municipality where the products are to be sold. Tobacco licenses shall expire midnight, April 30, of each year.

* * *

(d) A person applying simultaneously for a tobacco license and a liquor license shall apply to the legislative body of the municipality and shall pay to the Department only the fee required to obtain the liquor license. A person applying for a tobacco license only shall submit a fee of \$100.00 to the legislative body of the municipality for each tobacco license or renewal. The municipal clerk shall forward the application to the Department, and the Department shall issue the tobacco license. The tobacco license fee shall be forwarded to the Commissioner for deposit in the Liquor Control Enterprise Fund.

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(h) On or before the 15th of each month, the city or town clerk shall submit to the Board the names, addresses, and license numbers of all persons to whom a tobacco license was issued during the previous month. Each year, on or

- before May 15, the city or town clerk shall submit to the Board a list of all
