18	In a public building, except a shopping center, shopping mall, health care
19	provider, or a terminal, depot, or other public transportation terminal, an
20	accessible route by elevator or platform lift is not required for:

1	(1) A multi-family dwelling unit in a building which consists of three
2	stories or fewer, Unless required by federal law.
3	(2) A two-story retail establishment with a total of 15,000 square feet or
4	<u>less.</u>
5	(3) A three-story retail establishment with less than 3,000 square feet
6	per story.
7	(4) A story or floor less than 3,000 square feet. Storage, stairwell,
8	elevator, or vertical lift, shaft, and mechanical spaces are exempt from the
9	3,000 square foot calculation.
10	(5) A mezzanine in a one-story building.
11	(6) A story or floor used for storage that is accessed only on an
12	infrequent basis or is not occupiable.
