(b) Expenditures for administrative and overhead expenses of the operation of the lottery, except agent and bank commissions, shall be paid from lottery receipts from an appropriation authorized for that purpose. Agent commissions shall be set by the lottery commission Lottery Commission and may not exceed 6.25 percent of gross receipts and bank commissions may not exceed 4 one percent of gross receipts. Any store that sells a winning draw ticket shall receive its commission in a manner consistent with the rules adopted by the Lottery Commission.

(b) Expenditures for administrative and overhead expenses of the operation of the lottery, except agent and bank commissions, shall be paid from lottery receipts from an appropriation authorized for that purpose. Agent commissions shall be set by the lottery commission Lottery Commission and may not exceed 6.25 percent of gross receipts and bank commissions may not exceed 1 percent of gross receipts. Once the draw game results become

official, the payment of any commission on any draw game ticket that wins at least \$10,000.00 shall be made through the normal course of processing payments to lottery agents, regardless of whether the winning ticket is claimed.

This act shall take effect on July 1, 2014.
