An act relating to approval of amendments to the charter of the Village of Derby Line

It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

Sec. 1. CHARTER AMENDMENT APPROVAL

The General Assembly approves amendments to the charter of the Village of Derby Line as set forth in this act. Proposals of amendment were approved by the voters on August 20, 2013.

Sec. 2. 24 App. V.S.A. chapter 217 is amended to read:

CHAPTER 217. VILLAGE OF DERBY LINE

* * *

Subchapter 2. Annual and Special Meetings

§ 201. WARNING OF MEETING AND QUALIFIED VOTERS

- (a) The annual meetings of said corporation the Village of Derby Line shall be holden held on the first Tuesday in April in each year at such hour as the notice hereinafter mentioned shall state, in the town hall Town Hall in said village the Village, or at such other time and place as said corporation the Village shall hereafter appoint, of which a notice.
- (b) Notice for such meetings shall be posted in at least three public places in said village the Village, at least ten days previous to said a meeting, which.

 The notice shall be signed by the clerk of the corporation Clerk of the Village, and, in case of the clerk's Clerk's failure so to do, by a majority of the trustees

<u>Trustees</u> of <u>said village</u> the <u>Village</u>, and for want of <u>such trustees</u> the <u>Trustees</u>, or upon their failure so to do, by a majority of the justices of the peace residing in <u>said village</u>; and <u>whenever</u> the <u>Village</u>.

- (c) Whenever five legal voters residing in said village the Village shall so request, the elerk Clerk, and upon the elerk's Clerk's neglect or refusal, the trustees Trustees may call a special meeting of said corporation the Village, giving like notice of the same special meeting as provided in subsection (b) of this section, and specifying in said the notice the object of said the special meeting and the business to be done at the same; and at such meetings none but inhabitants qualified to vote in town meeting in said town and who shall have resided for one year within the bounds of said corporation shall be entitled to vote special meeting.
- (d) At a meeting held under this section, only the inhabitants of the Village who meet the qualifications of 17 V.S.A. § 2121 and who are on the voter checklist of the Village shall be entitled to vote.

§ 202. OFFICERS TO BE ELECTED AT ANNUAL MEETING

(a) At the annual meeting of said corporation there the Village, the following officers shall be elected, by ballot if called for, for the ensuing year except as provided in subsection (d) of this section, and until their successors are chosen;:

- (1) a moderator Moderator, who shall preside at all meetings of said corporation the Village with powers of moderators at town meetings;
- (2) a elerk Clerk, who shall keep a record of the proceedings of meetings of said corporation the Village, with power to certify to copies of the same, and who shall perform all the duties of a clerk;
- (3) three trustees <u>Trustees</u>, subject to the provisions <u>hereinafter</u> eontained of subsection (d) of this section, who shall have the management of the affairs of <u>said corporation</u> the <u>Village</u>, with the necessary powers for that purpose, who may fill vacancies in the offices of <u>said corporation</u>; the <u>Village</u>, may act by a majority, and of whom the oldest in office present at any meeting of <u>said corporation</u> the <u>Village</u> shall preside, when the <u>moderator Moderator</u> is absent;
- (4) a treasurer and a collector Treasurer, who shall be sworn and shall discharge the usual duties of a treasurer;
- (5) a Tax Collector, who shall be sworn and shall discharge the usual duties of such officers, and shall give bonds in such sums as said corporation shall direct for the faithful performance of the same, within ten days after their election or appointment or the office shall be vacant a tax collector; and
- (6) such other officers as said by-laws the bylaws of the Village require; and such officers, who shall have all the powers necessary for the purposes of their office.

(b) The Treasurer and the Tax Collector shall give bonds within 10 days

the faithful performance of their duties. Failure to give such a bond within that

time period shall cause the office to be vacant.

(c) Candidates for the offices of Clerk, Treasurer, and Tax Collector do not

need to be residents of the Village, but shall be residents of the Town of Derby

as shown by their inclusion on the Town voter checklist.

(d) There shall be elected at the annual meeting of 1911 three trustees

<u>Trustees</u> for a term of one, two, and three years, respectively, and thereafter, at

each annual meeting, a trustee one Trustee shall be elected for the term of three

years, to succeed the trustee Trustee whose term expires, and a. A vacancy in

such office may be filled at an annual meeting.
