6 Statement of purpose of bill as introduced: This bill proposes to allow the
7 holder of a first-class license to serve up to four glasses of malt beverages to a
8 customer at a single time.

9 An act relating to service of malt beverages by the glass

10 It is hereby enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Vermont:

11 Sec. 1. 7 V.S.A. § 222 is amended to read:

12 § 222. ~~FIRST AND SECOND-CLASS~~ FIRST- AND SECOND-CLASS
13 LICENSES, GRANTING OF; SALE TO MINORS; CONTRACTING
14 FOR FOOD SERVICE

15 With the approval of the Liquor Control Board, the Control Commissioners
16 may grant to a retail dealer for the premises where the dealer carries on
17 business the following:

18 * * *

19 (5) The holder of a first-class license may serve up to four glasses of
20 malt beverages to a customer at one time. If the number of glasses served to a

1 customer at a single time exceeds two, each glass shall contain no more than

2 four ounces of malt beverage.
